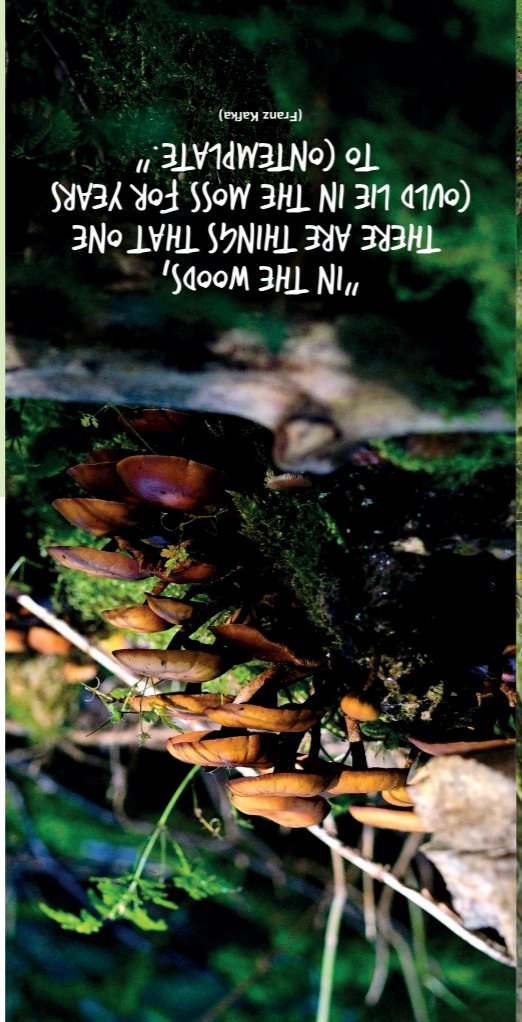

RESPECTING THE NATIONAL PARK

We are preserving wild nature, which provides a habitat for animals and plants, ensures the natural diversity of our world and fascinates human beings. Experiencing nature should not conflict with nature protection – therefore special rules apply in the National Park.

Stay on the marked trails.

Keep dogs on the leash.

Gather only impressions and observations.

Do not smoke and do not light any fires.

Avoid making noise.

Take your waste with you. It does not belong in nature!

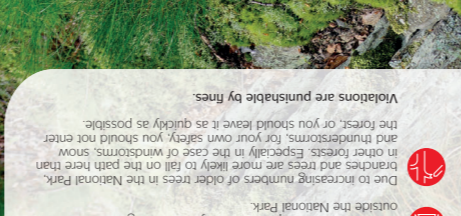
Bicycles are permitted only on the designated cycle routes.

Do not fly any drones or other flying objects.

Staying overnight in the Park is forbidden. Camping in tents and motorhomes is permitted only at the designated locations outside the National Park.

Due to increasing numbers of older trees in the National Park, branches and trees are more likely to fall on the path here than in other forests. Especially in the case of windstorms, snow and thunderstorms, for your own safety, you should not enter the forest, or you should leave it as quickly as possible.

Violations are punishable by fines.



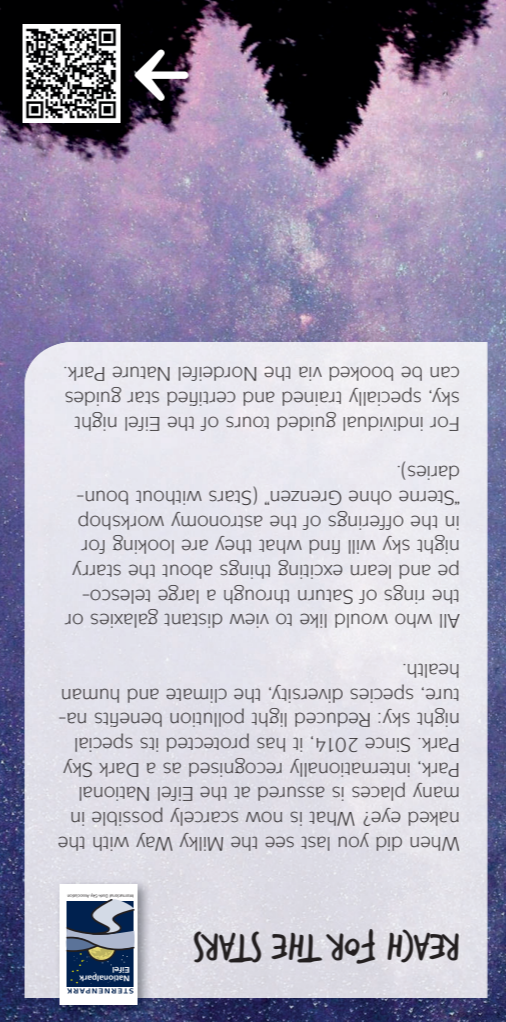
WHAT DOES BEAVER FUR FEEL LIKE?

All who wish to learn about the senses of dragonflies, owls and other animals, or feel the soft fur of a beaver or deer will find what they are looking for at the major National Park exhibition "Dreams of Wilderness". The exhibits range from tiny insects to magnificent mammals. Modern installations take guests into a world full of surprising discoveries.

You can experience the fully accessible exhibition on your own or on a tour guided by a National Park ranger. Customised guided tours for groups are also available.

Opening hours: Daily from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. (December 24 and December 31 until 2 p.m.)

Admission: 8 euros (reduced: 4 euros) | Family ticket: 18 euros | Free admission for children under 7 years old, and for birthday children of any age

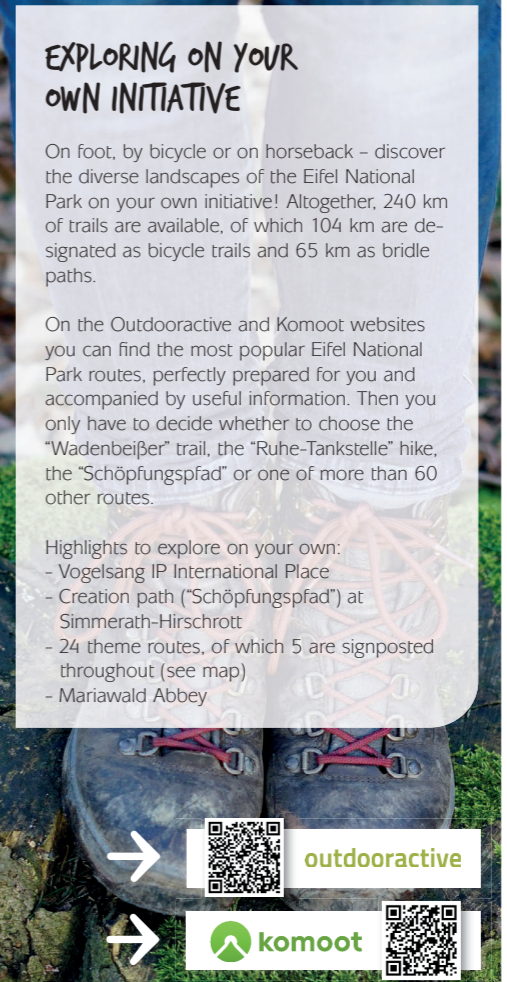


REACH FOR THE STARS

When did you last see the Milky Way with the naked eye? What is now scarcely possible in National Park! Experience nature independent of a wide variety of restrictions. Whether indoors or outdoors, whether restricted with regard to mobility or sensory perceptions, all can use various senses to perceive the emerging wilderness of the National Park at the major interactive exhibition "Dreams of Wilderness", on the "Wilder Weg" nature discovery path in the fully accessible Wild Kermeter area for experiencing nature, and at many other locations.

All who would like to view distant galaxies or the rings of Saturn through a large telescope and learn exciting things about the starry night sky will find what they are looking for in the offerings of the astronomy workshop "Sterne ohne Grenzen" (Stars without boundaries).

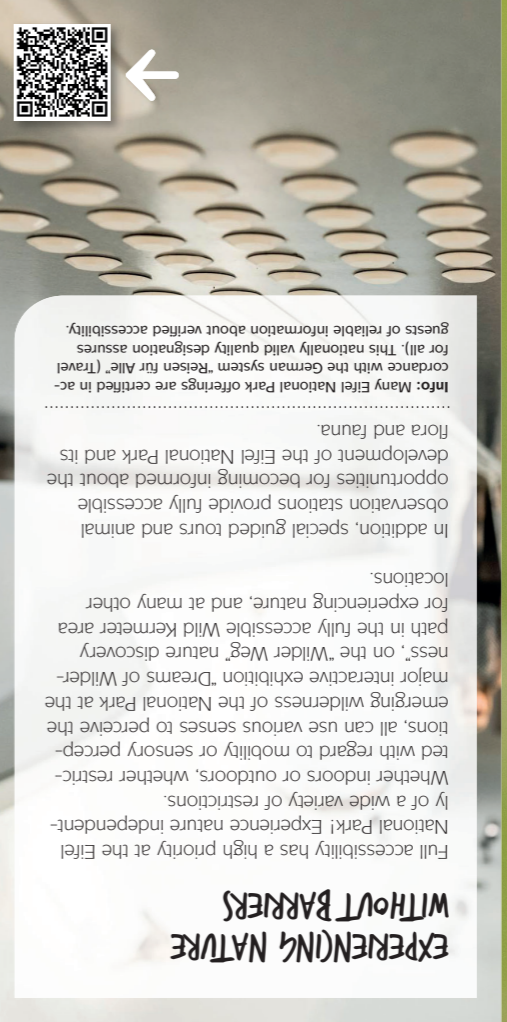
For individual guided tours of the Eifel night sky, specially trained and certified star guides can be booked via the Nordifel Nature Park.

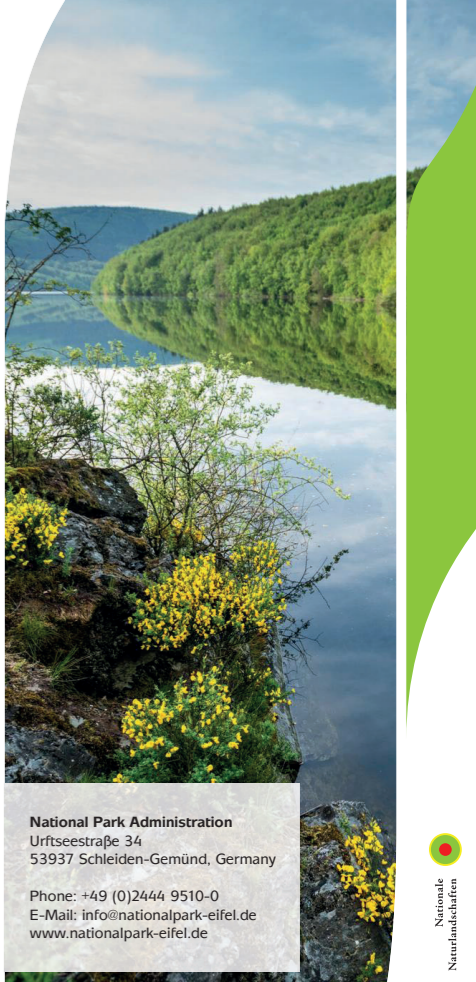
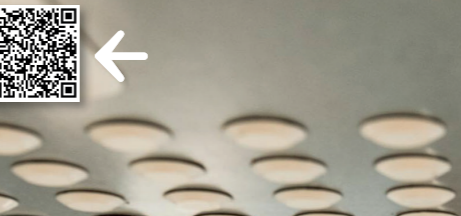
